- 7. Popular participation in development is best perceived as transactional communication. Explain this concept with reference to at least one development project in Sri Lankan society.
- 8. The role played by Non-Governmental Organizations (NGO's) in the context of our national crises needs to be assessed in a balanced manner. Discuss.
- 9. What is the potential of agricultural extension systems in the context of modernization of agriculture in Sri Lankan society?
