1. Discuss Fishman's (1965) statement that "Habitual choice in multilingual societies is far from being a random matter."

Your answer should outline and discuss the social factors that affect choice of language or a variety.

- 2. "Social relationships can be extended, defined and manipulated through the use of speech." Examine the use of either kinship terms or personal pronouns in the light of this statement."
- 3. "The role of a national government does not stop at selecting a national language" (Trudgill 1987)

Comment on the role of government (or state) in selecting a language as a national / official language. Illustrate your answer with reference to at least 3 modern nations, including Sri Lanka.

4. According to sociologists, human communication is not neutral but affected by consideration of gender.

Discuss this point of view, and compare and contrast the use of language by men and women in different social contexts.

5. "Neither of the terms 'dialect' or 'language' represent a clear-cut or water-tight concept."

Using this as the starting point of your answer, comment on the distinction between 'dialect' and 'language'.

- 6. "It seems to be virtually impossible to speed up the language learning process". Discuss, the stages of Child Language Acquisition giving appropriate examples.
- 7. Children proceed through certain phases in reading, from b4eing unable to read to possessing a normal adult level of reading. Support this view with adequate examples.
- 8. Discuss how you, as a teacher in ELT, would identify children with language disabilities. You MUST refer to at least FIVE different types of language disorders.
- 9. "Children often take one feature of an object, and then, wherever that feature occurs, they use the word they know that has that feature". In the light of the above comment, discuss the systematic nature of the Mental Lexicon in children.
