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

The modern economy is said to have been 'globalized' by the communication revolution that began shortly after World War II, as the voice of America and other shortwave broadcasters provided information about the Western world to those locked behind the communist 'Iron Curtain'. Global communication was hastened by the onset of fax machines and has within the past decade <u>accelerated dramatically</u> with the internet.

One effect of the communication revolution has been the development of global trading blocks and world trade agreements. Global trading blocks such as the North American Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA), Latin America's MERCOSUR, Asia's ASEAN, and the European Union (EU) have all originated within the past twenty years. The EU provides a good example of how the power of communication has transformed the world. Just five decades earlier, the entire continent was struggling with a devastating war. Now, former bitter enemies, having seen the similarities that underlie their differences, have decided to join <u>under a common banner</u> for the sake of their economic futures.

The growth of regional free trade agreements and the global World Trade Organisation (WTO) presents a new set of challenges and opportunities for managers. Free trade allows firms from anywhere in the

Use only. world to gain access to local markets. The onset of NAFTA, for example, has been a boon to several US companies such as Wal - Mart who have found the Mexican market to be eager for their products. Another benefit of free trade agreements is the increased labour pool. ...... Manufacturing companies, in particular, have reduced costs by moving some of their production to areas where labour is plentiful and cheap. Many American manufacturers have, at least in the past, shifted their . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . production to Maxico to take advantages of its relatively cheap, yet . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . skilled labour. These cost savings are passed on to the consumer, who also benefits from the added competition in the market that is created by foreign goods. Not everyone agrees that regional trading blocks offer benefits that exceed their costs. Certainly, shifting manufacturing production to foreign location has cost some American workers, including many American Managers, their jobs. In addition, may companies have had to adjust their approach to their domestic markets because of the . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . sudden influx of competitively priced foreign products. The consumer is the one who benefits from this competition. Managers must find . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . ways to beat foreign competition on price and quality as consumer . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . . choices widen. The globalization trend is not likely to change in the coming Unless there is a major world war, the communication years. revolution and the worldwide shift to free markets is likely to continue. There will always be disagreement regarding acceptable fair trade practices, but the mechanics are now being put in place that will allow for these disagreements to be handled peacefully. 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
