- 1. Appraise the type of policies that need to be formulated to address issues relating to the population profile of Sri Lanka with special reference to elderly population of the country.
- 2. The social indicators in the 1977-86 periods were described as 'steady progress in the economy' and it was the direct outcome of the economic reforms of Sri Lanka. Describe this statement with suitable examples.
- 3. Evaluate as to what extent the government policy made impact on reduction of rural poverty in Sri Lanka.
- 4. Review some of the major impacts on labour in the privatized plantation industry in Sri Lanka.
- 5. Critically assess the outcomes of the housing projects implemented during 1980 -1990 period and its impact on social integration in Sri Lanka.
- 6. Examine the distinction between self-sufficiency in food and food security in Sri Lanka.
- 7. The 8 hour work day is an exceptional achievement as far as victory of trade union movements. Discuss critically.

- 10. Write short notes on the following topics.

 - b) Land Reforms and its impact on the plantation community in Sri Lanka.
